

# Carlyle Tour for IMHP Students

On June 9th, Swinerton Builders Los Angeles provided a jobsite tour of The Carlyle project for the school students of Institute for Maximum Human Potential (IMHP). The purpose was to educate the students on the many different processes on a jobsite and let them experience an actual project in-progress, as this was the first time the IMHP students had ever been to a commercial construction jobsite. This was the second job shadow day Swinerton Builders Los Angeles hosted this year for the IMHP students. The previous day was in September and the students came to the office to learn about various components of construction and career opportunities that exist in the industry.

IMHP is a community based agency that focuses on the most vulnerable families in underserved communities. The target communities are located in Watts, Willowbrook and South Los Angeles. This area is one of the poorest in Los Angeles County, with 40% of the population dependent upon public assistance. IMHP programs take a holistic approach to provide best practices in case management and community development, focusing on capabilities of individual and families
